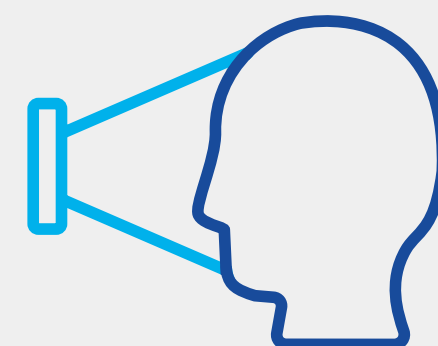
Now screening over **100,000** people each year

Over **130** community-based screening locations nationally

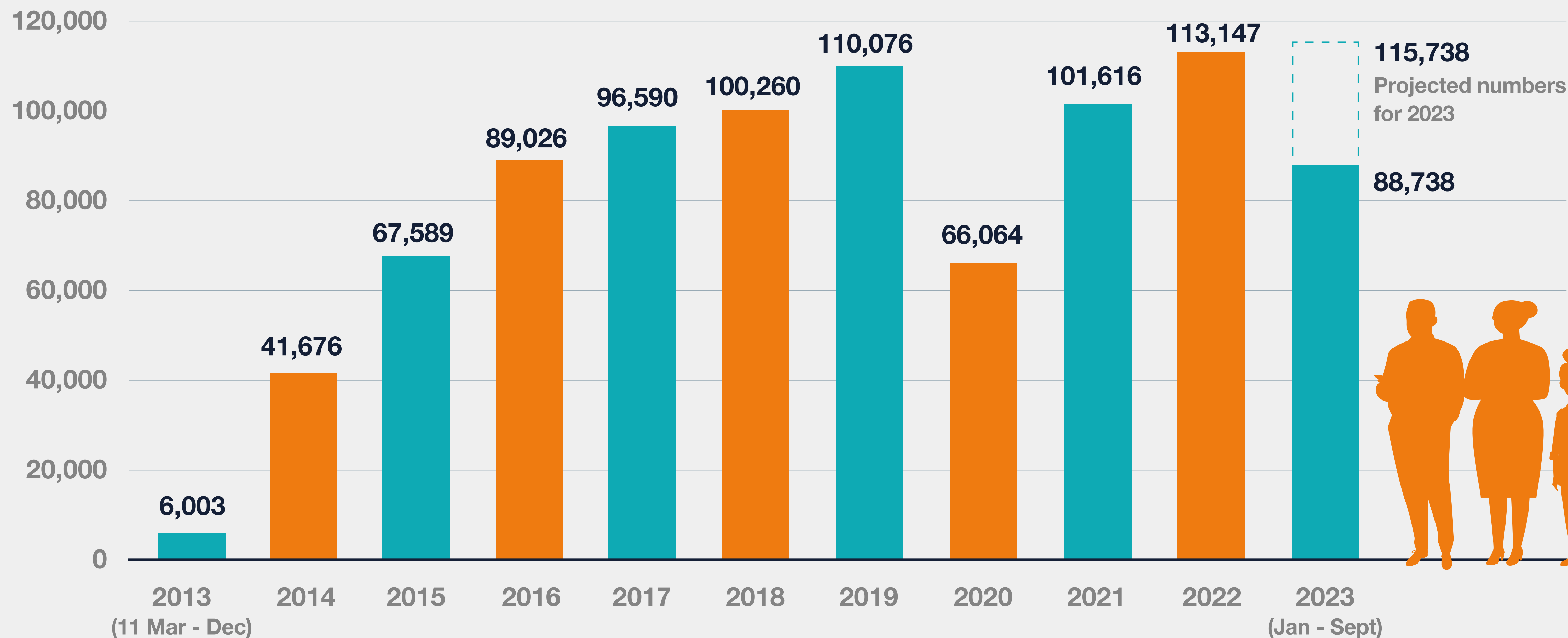

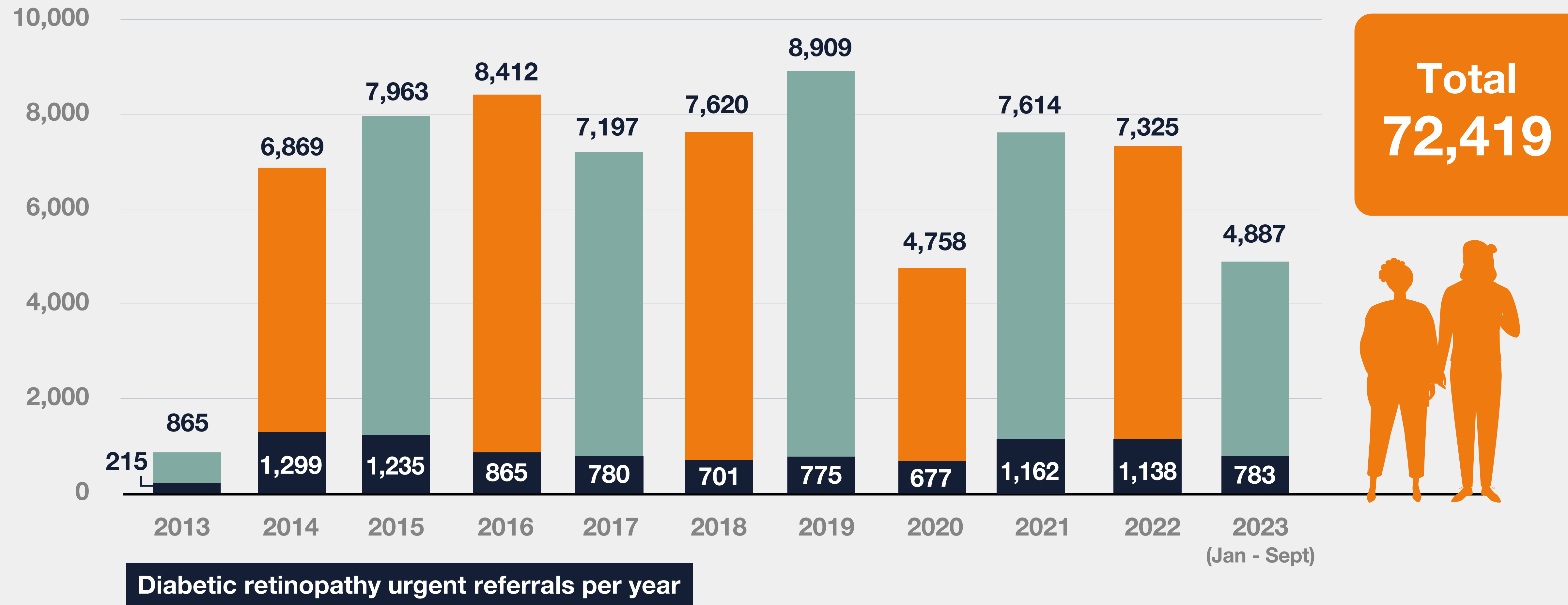

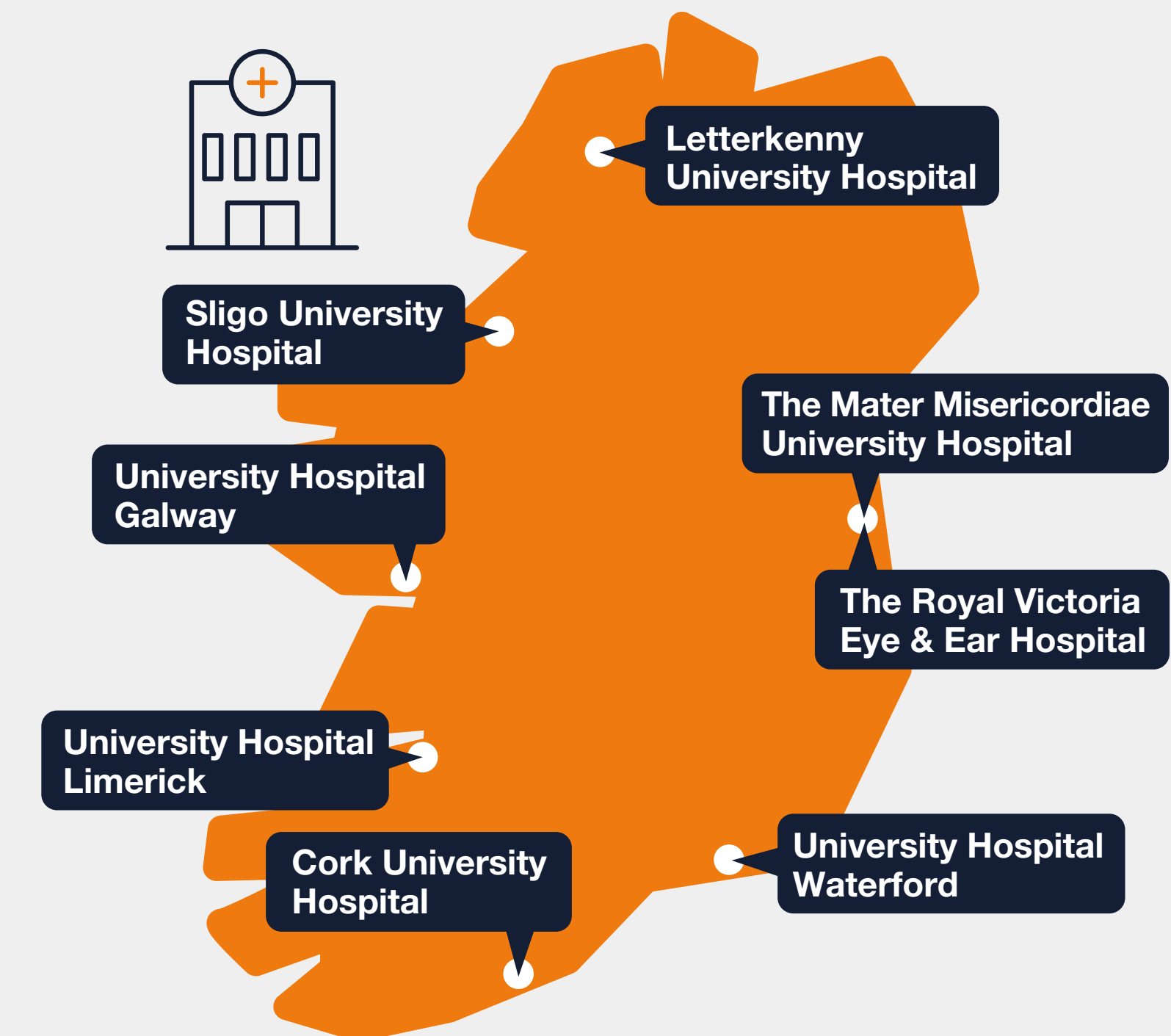

5 Screening pathways

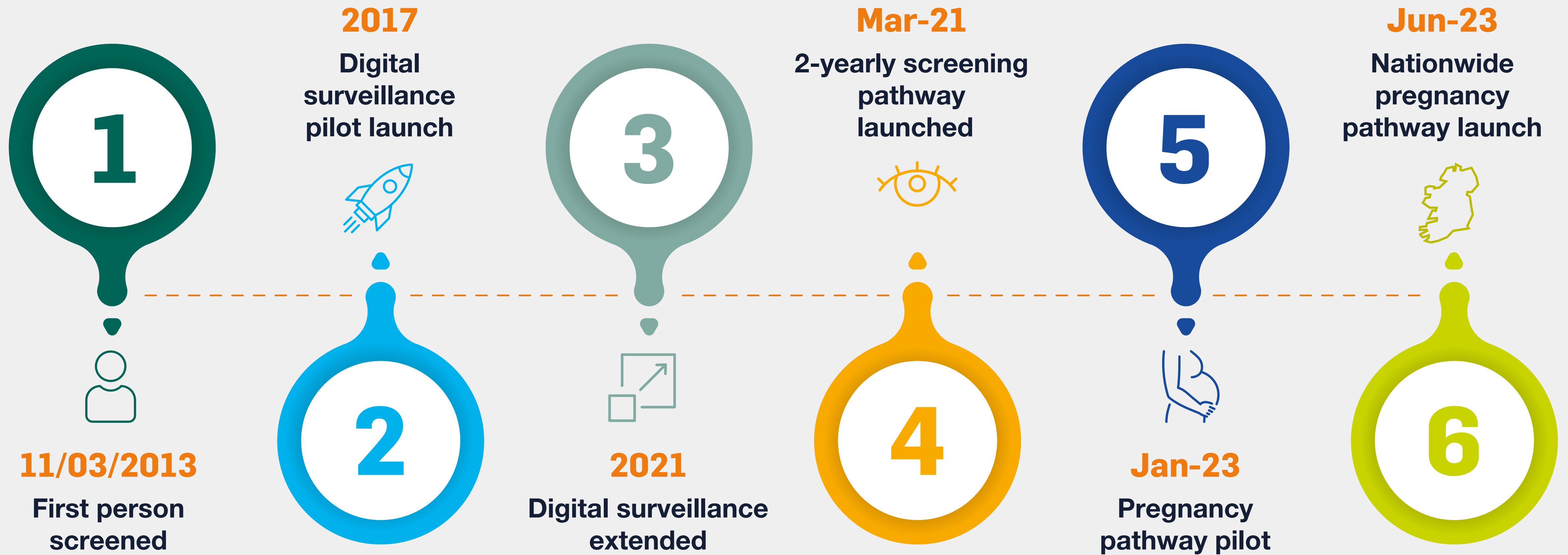
- Routine recall annually

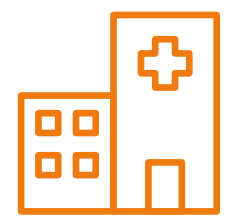
