KNOW THE SYMPTOMS - SAVE LIVES



- Very fast breathing
- Having fits or convulsions
- Skin looks mottled, bluish or pale
- Has a rash that does not fade when pressed
- Is unusually sleepy and difficult to wake
- Feels unusually cold when you touch them

Things to watch out for if your child is under 5 years old:

- not feeding
- vomiting repeatedly
- dry when you change them and have not had a wet nappy for the last 12 hours
