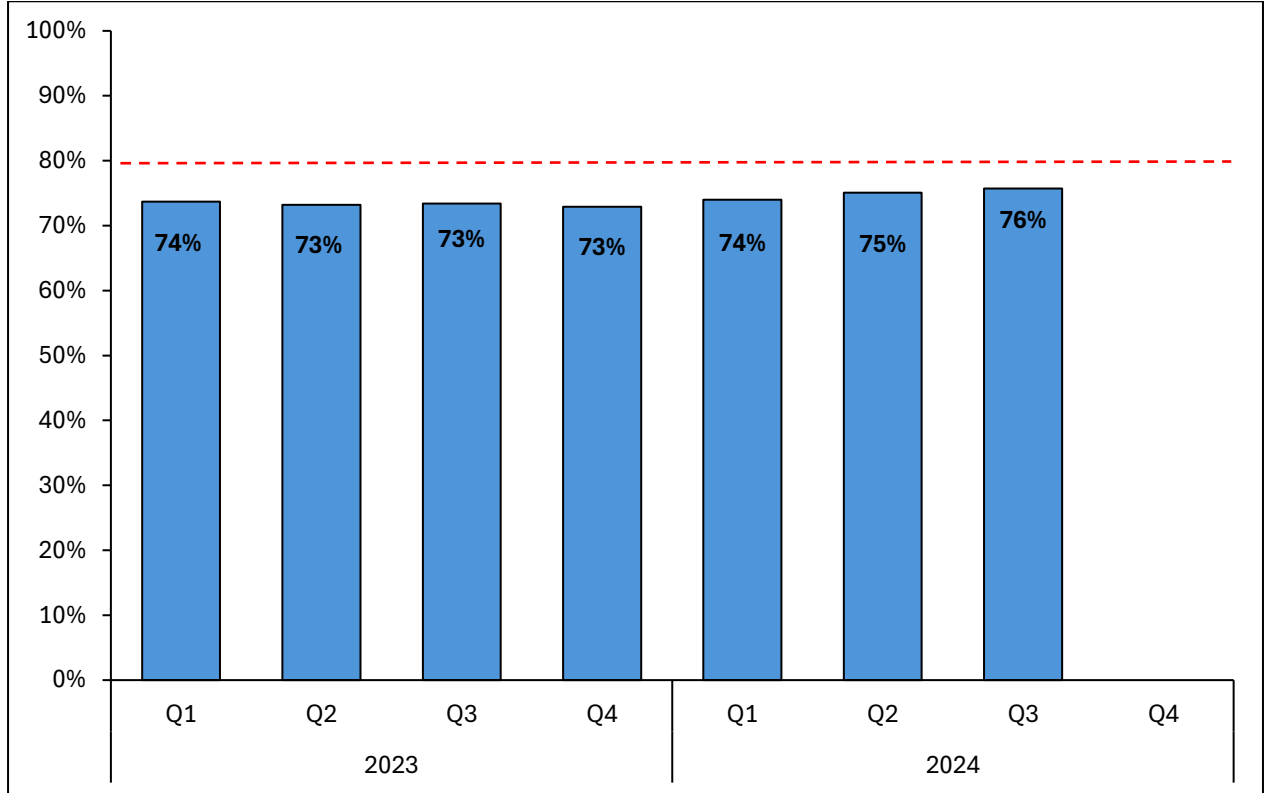
# Activity and Performance Data

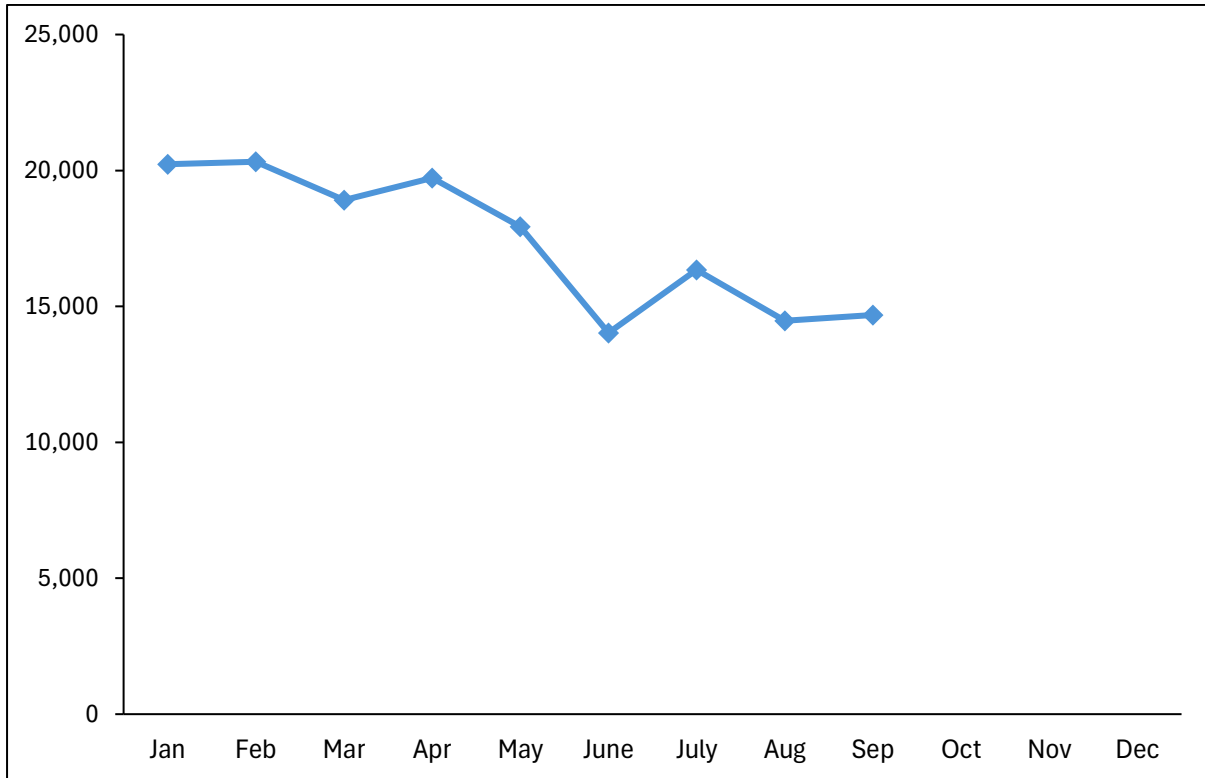

- Coverage for the third quarter of 2024 (75.7%) saw an increase from the previous quarter.
- Coverage remains below the standard of 80% which is to be expected as the screening age range was extended in March 2020 and not all women in this age group have had the opportunity to take up their screening appointment yet.
