Celebrating Success: Inaugural Patient Flow Academy Conference

In November 2024, HSE Spark proudly partnered with the HSE Patient Flow Academy for its first conference, themed "Changing Outcomes, Improving Together."

The conference's main aim was to enhance patient flow in our services by supporting healthcare staff in identifying, defining, and improving processes, pathways, and systems for the safe and timely delivery of care while creating a community of improvement and excellence in safe patient care.

A highlight of the event was the patient story – Catherine Murphy told the story of her father Pat Dineen and his family's journey as they traversed illness and his final days in and out of hospital. It was a beautiful story, beautifully delivered by Catherine and reminded everyone in the room about what really matters – the people we care for.


The Patient Flow Academy Conference also featured expert speakers, engaging panels, and networking opportunities, fostering a culture of continuous improvement and collaboration among healthcare professionals. Attendees shared best practices and innovative solutions to address patient flow challenges, contributing to the overall enhancement of healthcare delivery in Ireland.












The day also featured the introduction of the Patient Flow Academy Excellence Awards, in collaboration with the Spark Innovation Programme. These awards recognised projects completed over the previous five years that had significantly improved patient flow in the sites they were established in. Awards of up to €5,000 were granted, with a particular focus on areas such as integrated operations, demand and capacity management, ward processes, integrated discharge processes, older persons care and frailty, and length of stay reduction.

The Patient Flow Academy Conference was a celebration of patient safety and excellence; however, it was also a platform to shine a light on the greatest asset of our health service – the staff who work tirelessly to improve and innovate with the patient and their families at the centre of all they do.

Consultant Innovation Fund 2025

Consultant Innovation Fund 2025: Driving Change Together

The Consultant Innovation Fund under the Public Only Consultant Contract (POCC) 2023 offers an exciting opportunity for healthcare workers across the HSE to lead meaningful innovation. This fund empowers consultants to implement projects aimed at enhancing patient care, fostering teamwork, and introducing cutting-edge solutions to clinical practice.

How Does It Work?

The fund provides up to €8,000 per calendar year for individual projects, with the potential to pool unused CME funds for a total of €20,000 annually. Larger collaborative projects can access up to €50,000, depending on the scope and funding calls. Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis, and early submissions are encouraged to secure timely approval.

Key Achievements

- Reduced waiting times from 18 months to 3 months
- Saved €239,173 by reducing 187 inpatient bed days.
- Improved environmental impact with carbon savings of 906.085 kg CO2e.

The project's success demonstrates how collaborative care models can address complex healthcare challenges while improving patient experience.

- Expert input to refine their solutions










- Funding of up to €5,000 for idea development

Celebrating Excellence in Nursing and Midwifery

We are thrilled to highlight the remarkable achievements of Catherine Marsh, our National Nursing and Midwifery Fellow. Catherine's dedication and innovative contributions have significantly advanced healthcare practices, earning her well-deserved recognition.

Recently, Catherine, alongside her colleagues, received the **Best Nursing & Midwifery Project of the Year Award** at the prestigious Irish Healthcare Awards 2024. This accolade is a testament to the outstanding work within the Sexual Assault Treatment Unit (SATU) at the Rotunda Hospital, made possible with the support of the Spark Innovation Programme.

Since early 2024, the HSE Sexual Assault Treatment Unit (SATU) at Rotunda Hospital, Dublin 1, has been trialling the inclusion of forensic photography as part of its service. This project integrates photography within SATU to reduce patient stress, visit length, and provide trauma-informed care. By completing this simple yet vital element of a forensic examination onsite, the hope is to reduce the number of people an individual needs to interact with at a time of immense crisis, as well as making their visit to the SATU much shorter.







Evidence collected by SATUs may play a crucial role in investigations of sexual violence. Currently, body injury photographs are taken by An Garda Síochána, but offering photography as part of the SATU service aims to reduce the stress and duration of SATU attendance and lessen the burden on other agencies. The Rotunda SATU sees 42% of the people attending the SATU service nationally, making it the natural choice for a robust assessment in terms of the quantity and diversity of people seen. There is no statute of limitations when reporting a sexual crime, and timely collection of evidence gives individuals more options.

In a recent interview with RTÉ Radio 1, Catherine shared insights into her journey and the challenges she has overcome in her career. She emphasised the importance of continuous learning and collaboration in the healthcare sector. Her passion for nursing and midwifery shines through as she discusses her vision for the future of healthcare in Ireland.
